



# BEAR PONG

## YOU WILL NEED

Bear Pong leaderboard, labels and winners medal (available online)

Plastic cups

Ping pong balls

Table

## GET SET

Print off your Bear Pong leaderboard and labels from our website, as well as the medal for the winner.

At one end of a long table, place plastic cups. (We used 25 cups set up in five rows).

Write a number inside each cup.

Place your ping pong balls at the opposite end of the table.

**You're good to go!**

## HOW TO PLAY

Standing at the end of the table, the aim is to bounce the Ping Pong balls so that they land (and stay) in the cups.

Each player gets three attempts. When your ball lands in a cup, you score the points written inside that cup. Miss the cup and it's a zero. Add up the points from your three attempts for your total score.

Once the player has finished their turn, add their name and total score to a label and pop it on the leaderboard.

The player with the highest score is the winner - celebrate their win by honouring them with their very own Bear Pong medal.
